The aim of The Boys' Brigade is the all-round development of boys covering the following aspects: Spiritual, Physical, Enrichment and Social. Over the years, there has been a strong emphasis on outdoor adventure activities, leadership development, team building, and community involvement.

WHEN it comes to the poor and needy, God always has a powerful message for His people.

If there is a poor man among your brothers in any of the towns of the land that the Lord your God is giving you, do not be hardhearted or tightfisted toward your poor brother. Rather be openhanded and freely lend him whatever he needs. Be careful not to harbour this wicked thought: the seventh year, the year for cancelling debts, is near, so that you do not show ill will toward your needy brother and give him nothing. He may then appeal to the Lord against you, and you will be found guilty of sin. Give generously to him and do so without a grudging heart; then because of this the Lord your God will bless you in all your work and in everything you put your hand to. There will always be poor people in the land. Therefore I command you to be openhanded toward your brothers and toward the poor and needy in your land.

~ Deuteronomy 15:7-11

How true this is: there will always be poor people in our land. Even in affluent Singapore, we come across people who are struggling to make ends meet. One of the great Methodist evangelists, Rev Dr Alan Walker of Australia said: “the greatest menace to the world is a born-again Christian without a social conscience.”

As we take this 40 Days of Community journey and beyond, we will constantly be challenged to reach out to the community. Let the “Build up, Reach out” theme for the Year of Outreach spur us to get out of our comfort zone and reach out and love our neighbour.

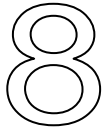

BMC Prison Ministry had a humble beginning in 2002 when 3 church volunteers, Martin Chia, Woon Sui Cheong and T Subramaniam, started Bible Study classes in Tanah Merah Prison. The ministry soon grew. In 2005, during the 40 Days of Spiritual Purpose Ministry Fair, 30 church members signed up as prison ministry volunteers.

In July 2005, BMC Prison Ministry was officially launched and it conducted its first Sunday Chapel Service at Changi Prison Complex (A5HU4). Today, the ministry has about 40 volunteers involved in in-care and aftercare ministry.
